

## **Proxy Letter:**

We have attached our proxy template should you not be able to attend this meeting. Given the technicalities involved with appointing a proxy to vote in a hybrid meeting, all proxy forms are encouraged to be submitted by **Friday, September 15, 2023** to Joanna Prince via email at joanna.prince@bcafn.ca.

For proxy voting in the election, the hard deadline to submit a complete proxy form to the Electoral Officer is 15 minutes prior to the opening of the election polls on September 20, 2023. Proxy forms received by the Electoral Officer after that deadline will be unable to vote in the election.

Per BCAFN Bylaw 4.25:

A proxy appointment is valid and a vote cast under authority of such appointment will be a valid vote if the vote is validly cast and if the appointment is:

- a) made in writing and signed by an authorized representative of the member;
- b) received by
- *i.* the Electoral Officer, in respect of a vote cast in an election, ... [or]
- *iii.* a BCAFN employee responsible for meeting registration, for any poll conducted by show of hands,
- *c)* received on or before the following cut-off times, depending on the type of poll and meeting format:
  - *i. fifteen (15) minutes before the taking of any poll conducted by show of hands, ... [or]*
  - *iii.* the opening of any secret ballot poll that is conducted at a hybrid meeting.
